The MEAC On Opening Day

The college football season opened last Saturday with four Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference teams on the road, and all four took it on the chin. Florida A&M met Grambling in New York's Yankee Stadium, and lost 21-10; South Carolina State traveled to Richmond, Kentucky where they lost to Eastern Kentucky 26-0; in Petersburg, Virginia, Delaware State dropped a heartbreaking 13-12 decision to Virginia State; and Bethune-Cookman suffered a tough 3-0 loss to Southern University in Baton Rouge.

Grambling took advantage of some early Rattler mental mistakes to beat back FAMU, despite a brilliant performance by quarterback Nathaniel Koonce. The junior hit on 19 or 37 passes for 224 yards, rushed for 33 more on 12 tries, and scored the lone FAMU touchdown on a two-yard burst.

S.C. State was forced to experiment with three different quarterbacks who fumbled five times between them, losing two, and suffered two interceptions. The Bulldogs never got much going on offense, while Eastern Kentucky started

all its drives in SCS territory except two.

DelState runningback Johnny Rowe caught two scoring passes in the first half, the last one off of a fake field goal, but both points-after failed. Virginia State missed its first PAT, but made good on the second one. With about three minutes left in the game, the Hornets drove down to the VSU 15 yard line only to be turned away on a fourth down and inches try.

Southern got a field goal early in the fourth quarter and held Bethune-Cookman at bay in a defensive battle Saturday night.

Howard University and North Carolina A&T will open up this Saturday with both playing at home. Howard hosts Cheyney State, while NCA&T entertains Winstonn-Salem State.

MEAC Player Of The Week

The Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference has named Johnny Rowe of Delaware State as its Offensive Player of the Week, and Steve Hammond of Bethune-Cookman as Defensive Player of the Week.

Last Saturday, Rowe, a 5-11, 205 pound runningback, put together 126 offensive yards, and caught touchdown passes of 27 and 18 yards in a 13-12 loss at Virginia State. The junior is from Belle Glade, Florida.

Second in the balloting was Nathaniel Koonce, quarterback of Florida A&M. In the 21-10 loss to Grambling Saturday night, he threw for 224 yards, rushed for 33, and

scored on a two-yard run. Koonce is from Miami, Florida.

Steve Hammond anchored the Bethune-Cookman defense in a tough 3-0 defeat at Southern University. The 6-2, 225 pound linebacker had three solo tackles, 16 assisted tackles, one sack, and two stops behind the line of scrimmage, the senior from Jacksonville, Florida is also a defensive captain.

Tim King of Delaware State was runnerup in this category. The senior captain was in on 11 tackles and intercepted two Virginia State passes. King is from Fort Meade, Florida.

HHS Cross Country Teams Ready For Season

Hillside High School's young Hornet cross country team should do extremely well in Big Six Conference competition, predicts head coach Russell Blunt. Boys' and girls' teams have returning 5,000 meter distance runners from last year's squad.

Four of this year's thirteen-member boys' team were on the 1980 team that tied for second place in the Big Six Conference Sectional meet. They are sophomores Musa Williams, John Hunter, Rod Hodge; and junior Tracy McAllister. New members of the boys' squad are freshman Rod Wilson, sophomore Randy Johnson, juniors Dwight Bostic, Everett Dean, Ricky Horton, Anthony Poole, Ronald Lloyd, Darron Steel and Keith Chestnut.

The girl's Hornet team is made up of ten dedicated runners, said Coach Blunt. Returning to the lineup are seniors Alia Brown, Angela Graham and Beth Wilson. The seven new members are freshmen Zaneta Roseboro, Cubie Sanford, Robin Thomas and Cassandra Richards. Juniors on the girls' team are Kim Moseley, Frankie Moore and Pam Harvey.

Hillside boys have run the cross country since 1967. Girls cross country started in 1978. Last year's girls' team was the first to participate in Big Six 5,000 meters cross country events (3.1 mile course).
