NCCU Criminal Justice Program Awards Scholarships

Two North Carolina Central University students have been given the "North Carolina Sheriff's Association Undergraduate Criminal Justice Scholarship" funded at the university by the North Carolina Sheriff's Association. The winners of the 1981-82 scholarships at North Carolina Central University are Ms. Eleanor Motley, a sophomore from Seaboard, N.C., and Ms. Debra L. McCrae, a senior from Maxton, N.C. The two scholarships are valued at \$750 each for the academic year. Ms. Motley, a graduate of Weldon High School, Weldon, N.C., plans a career in criminal justice involving work with juveniles, as does Ms. McCrae, a graduate of Maxton High School. The two students selected for the award by members of the faculty of the university's Criminal Justice Program. The awards were announced by Dr. Jess J. Bowe, director of the program.

Standard Oil Makes Deposits

CHICAGO—Standard Oil Company (Indiana) announced today it will purchase certificates of deposit totaling \$1.5 million from 60 minority-owned banks and savings and loan institutions. The \$25,000 one-year certificates were purchased recently. This year's program includes nine Chicago-area minority banks and savings and loans. Others are located in 28 states and the District of Columbia. Standard began its minority bank deposit program in 1965 in an attempt to strengthen those banks. Standard officials say the relationship is mutually beneficial in that minority institutions have been a position to make loans to the company and serve as investment vehicles for company funds. Total deposits by Standard in the minority-owned institutions this year expected to exceed \$100 million. Local institutions included in the program include Mechanics & Farmers Bank, and Greensboro National Bank.
