Miss Allison Joins Justice Department

The Goldsboro City Board of Education has appointed Jerry D. Johnson as assistant principal at Carver Heights School. Johnson, a physical education teacher at Goldsboro Middle School North, will replace Gerald Whitley as assistant principal. The appointment, made Tuesday during a special board meeting, is effective immediately.

Johnson came to Goldsboro from Green County where he was a physical education teacher. A native of Cedar Grove, he graduated from Central High School in Hillsborough in 1960 and from A&T State University in 1965 with a degree in health and physical education. He received a master's degree in physical education from East Carolina University in 1976 and will complete studies at ECU for a principal's certificate in January.
