## Wachovia To Install Sixth Teller II

Wachovia Bank and Trust Company will install a Teller II automated teller machine in the newly built Bryant Center on the campus of Duke University in Durham. Wachovia recently received permission from the U.S. Comptroller of the Currency to place the Teller II on Duke's campus, and the machine is scheduled to be in use by the first of May.

The Teller II will be located on the ground floor of the Bryant Center, and will be available for use 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Automated teller machines from two other banks will also be located in the Center.

"We are glad to put a Teller II in the student center where many students pass by between classes or visit during the day," said Lloyd G. Gurley, office executive of Wachovia in Durham. "Many Duke students,

faculty and staff members who are our customers don't get a chance to walk or drive over to Wachovia's Medical Center or West office during the day, so this machine will be a real convenience for them."

This will be Wachovia's sixth Teller II in Durham. Teller IIs are located at the Boulevard, Duke Medical Center, Avondale, West Durham and North Duke offices. It will be Wachovia's third automated teller machine located on the campus of a North Carolina university.

Wachovia's Teller II can be used to make deposits or payments and to obtain cash in multiples of \$5 up to a daily limit of \$200. It also gives account balance information and allows transfers of funds among accounts.
