#### NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The City Council of the City of Durham will hold a public hearing 7:30 P.M. on Monday evening, May 17, 1982, in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, 101 City Hall Plaza, Durham, North Carolina, to consider amending the Cable Television Franchise Ordinance. The City Council intends to consider amending Section 48 of the Cable Television Franchise Ordinance to provide that the franchisee (Cablevision of Durham, Incorporated) shall at all times make available to its customers a converter with the full capability of receiving and properly tuning all program sources which are provided by the franchisee, which converter shall be provided at a rate prescribed under Section 46 of the Cable Television Franchise Ordinance. The proposed amendment would also permit the franchisee to offer, at rates to be determined by the franchisee, more sophisticated and advanced converter models than that required by Section 46 of the Cable Television Franchise Ordinance.
