Big time track, featuring many world class track stars, returns to Durham the last weekend in June at Wallace Wade Stadium on the campus of Duke University.

The meet, scheduled for Saturday, June 26 and Sunday, June 27, is sponsored by Miller Lite.

Teams from the U.S., West Germany, and Africa will participate. Press co-ordinator Tom Mickle says "the West German team will be announced next week, and that the Pan African team has been chosen. The U.S. team will be selected at a similar meet in Knoxville, Tenn. two weeks before the Durham Meet."

Durham into the worldwide spotlight. Even soldiers in South Vietnam read about the meet because it was headlined in the Army's Stars and Stripes newspaper.

In 1973 a one day track event, the Dr. Martin Luther King Freedom Games, were held at Duke and drew 20,000 people.

The biggest Durham Track Meet to date was the U.S./USSR Meet of July 5-6, 1974. That one drew 65,000 track enthusiasts.

The last really big meet occurred here in 1975 when the U.S., Africa, and West Germans drew 37,800 people.

Tickets for this year's games can be purchased

for \$10 (reserved in advance) or \$7 each day; non-reserved tickets cost \$4 each day. Mail orders should be sent to P.O. Box 2312, Durham, N.C. 27702.

Tickets can be purchased at the following Triangle Area outlets: Mechanics and Farmers Bank in downtown Durham and Raleigh, NCNB Bank in downtown Durham, Raleigh, and Chapel Hill, or at the ticket office at Cameron Indoor Stadium on the Duke Campus.

Wallace Wade Stadium has been refurbished and there's not a bad seat in the "house".

The stadium has put Durham on the national and international sports map. It's the only place outside of Pasadena where the Rose Bowl has been played (Oregon 6, Duke 0 in 1942). In 1972 the Pelican Bowl or Black National Col-

legiate Championship was played here (Crambling 36, N.C. Central 6).

Duke has played many great teams and games here. N.C. Central and N.C. A.T. have also played several of their classics here — the most memorable a 9-7 last second Central win in 1972.

The stadium is located on the Duke West Campus (off Cameron Drive also called NC Hwy. 751), it is easily accessible from I-85, or the Durham East/West Freeway.
