

# History, Essay Collection, First Novel Top Book Club Summer Selections

The N.C. Book Club has chosen *Felice*, a first novel by Angela Davis-Gardner of Raleigh, as its current featured literary selection. The book, published by Random House in May, 1982, is the first novel

by Ms. Davis-Gardner, who is the daughter of historian and novelist Burke Davis, Jr., and the sister of novelist Burke Davis, III. The elder Davis's *Sherman's March* and the younger's *Dwelling Places*

were N.C. Book Club featured selections last winter. Ms. Davis-Gardner is the winner of a 1981 North Carolina fellowship award from the N. C. Arts Council for creative writing. The

\$5,000 fellowship was awarded in August for continuing development of her work. John Shelton Reed's latest work, *One South*, is the featured quarterly historical selection. Published by the Louisiana State University Press in June, 1982, *One South* is a collection of informal essays in which Reed focuses on the south's strong regional identity and on the persistence, well into the last decades of the 20th century, of Southern cultural distinctiveness. Reed is professor of sociology and adjunct professor of American studies at UNC-Chapel Hill.

*Rhyme; Islands, Capes and Sounds: The North Carolina Coast* by Thomas J. Schoenbaum; *North Carolina Lighthouses* by David Stick; and *North Carolina Legends* by Richard Walser.

Also *Bone of My Bones*, Sylvia Wilkinson's latest novel; *Moments of Light*, a collection of short stories by Fred Chappell; *Cakewalk*, a collection of short stories by Lee Smith; *A Mother and Two Daughters*, Gail Godwin's best selling novel; and *Dinner at the Homesick Restaurant*, Anne Tyler's best seller.

All of the above titles, plus a backlog of more than 30 books previously offered by the N. C. Book Club, can be ordered at prices substantially below the publisher's retail prices. The N.C. Book Club operates on a prepaid order plan, which means that no books are shipped until an order is received. Those ordering through the book club are under no obligation to buy a certain number of books per year.

## Mr. T of 'Rocky III' To Guest Star In 'Silver Spoons' Episode

Mr. T., who plays the powerful boxing opponent of the character portrayed by Sylvester Stallone in the popular motion picture "Rocky III," will guest-star in an episode of "Silver Spoons," NCB-TV's coming series starring Rick Schroder and Joel Higgins (Saturdays, 8:30-9 p.m., NYT starting this fall).

In the episode, Mr. T. will play the bodyguard hired by multi-millionaire Edward Stratton (Higgins) to protect his young son, Ricky (Schroder).

Being a bodyguard is nothing new to Mr. T., who has served in that capacity to celebrities such as LeVar Burton, Muhammad Ali, Michael Jackson and Leon Spinks. He

is nicknamed "The Bodyguard" and that's the title of his coming autobiography focusing on his experiences in that profession.

Born Lawrence Tero in Chicago, he was a three-time city wrestling champion with 90 victories and one loss while he was a high school student. He also scored 35 touchdowns as a spectacular halfback and earned a scholarship to Prairie View A&M where he played for three years. Later he tried out for the Green Bay Packers but was forced out of training camp after suffering a knee injury.

In addition to "Rocky III," he appears in the motion picture "Penitentiary III."
