Ms. Mills, a native of Reidsville, said that she visited some rural areas in Dakar. "I felt more comfortable in the rural areas than I did in the city," she said. "the pace of life was much slower and I liked that."

"She said that many young Senegalese men are merchants."

"They are in the market places and on the street corners from early in the morning until late at night," she said. They are real entrepreneurs, selling everything from watches to ink pens."

With her thoughts returning to Goree, she said, "I want back time and time again. I watched the clear blue waters of the Atlantic as the slaves must have watched them. I imagined their misery as they were treated like dogs and sold like fish and cattle."

[NNPA] The long awaited release of approximately 2,000 Haitian refugees in Florida has begun — others will follow.

In compliance with a federal judge's order, an Immigration and Naturalization

spokesman, said "We are going ahead in full force and planning on the release of the Haitians from various facilities around the country."

Volunteer agencies were set up in facilities at the Krome detention

center in Miami for the purpose of interviewing the Haitians for release. The processing includes photographs, fingerprints and personal histories for each refugee.
