the VA facility. Ford then called on the Congressional Black Caucus to lend their support for Meharry. Together they authored a letter to President Reagan reminding him of the Executive Order he had issued last September, reaffirming the government's commitment to the nation's 111 predominantly black colleges. In addition, Ford also enlisted the support of Senator Howard Baker of Tennessee. In responding to the Congressman's letter, the President appointed a five-agency task force

consisting of representatives from the departments of Health and Human Services, Education, Justice, the Veterans Administration, and the Office of Management and Budget to study the Meharry situation. Furthermore, Ford also met with the Administrator of the Veteran's Administration, Robert Nimmo.

Subsequently, the Reagan Administration announced that Meharry will be able to train its students at the Nashville VA hospital, and that eventually the VA hospital in Murfreesboro (33 miles from Nashville), will be renovated and expanded to provide Meharry with a permanent training facility.
