Ms. White bid straight six, hoping for some help, either from the kitty, her partner or both.

She got neither.

The Patterson-Lyon team turned three books, stopping the White-Flowers team from

making the 11 books they had planned to turn. Ms. White and her partner were six in the hole.

On the next hand, the Patterson-Lyon team got good hands, but missed their five, no-with bid, too.

For the next seven hands, the game see-sawed, with neither team able to gain and keep an advantage.

But then Ms. White got what whist enthusiasts call a "road map." That describes a hand with practically all winn-

ing cards that lead the players directly to "Boston."

The White-Flowers team bid six-no uptown, and captured 12 books.

When it was all over, the four players slumped. The two losers lit cigarettes, while the winners dashed off a couple of small glasses of white wine. Minutes later, the cards were being shuffled again. The players were in place. The fires of revenge burned in the eyes of the Patterson-Lyon team. Ms. White's and her partner's jaws were set with the firm

determination to do it again. And as the cards began skidding across the table, smiles and frowns flitted back and forth across the four faces like flashing neon lights. They went after each other with vengeance. Bid whist is not a game for the faint hearted. It's war, and like the famed former pro football coach, the late Vince Lombardi said: "Winning is not just the best thing; it's the only thing."

In bid whist, no truer words have ever been spoken.

The Black Family Plan Called Evil Says Goodlett

By an overwhelming 71 percent majority, a television opinion poll approved a "Black Family" self-help plan proposed by the Congressional Black Caucus (CBC). The poll was taken in Cincinnati, Ohio during a live-tecast of *Tony Brown's Journal*, which utilized the Q.U.B.E two-way talk-back system.

The special program entitled "Congressional Black Caucus Plan: Yes or No?" analyzed the merits of a proposal by the C.B.C for a national black self-help movement.

Tony Brown's Journal, is the nation's longest running black affairs series and has been sponsored by Pepsi-Cola Company for seven consecutive years. Televised nationally on public television (PBS), the program will be seen in this area on WUNC at 7:30 on Thursday Sept. 23.

In an interview with host Tony Brown, C.B.C. Chairman Walter Fauntroy argued the merits of the plan which he describes as a proposal for the unity, survival and progress of black people. Fauntroy, a Congressional Delegate for the District of Columbia, said that the plan was designed to meet the current across-the-board challenge to the quality of life for all black Americans and he outlined its twelve major points.

However, Dr. Carlton Goodlett, publisher of *Reporter Publications* in California, said the plan was one of the most pitiful remedies ever prepared and describes it as a plan for genocide, not for survival. He called it an "evil document" tragically compounded by "would-be leaders." Dr. Goodlett felt that because plans haven't worked in the past decades, that blacks should adopt a basic ideology, and not agendas.

Congressman Fauntroy refuted Dr. Goodlett's assessment and said that Dr. Goodlett's apparent lack of familiarity of the plan prevented him from being a fair judge of the proposal. He added that these are unsettling times in black America and that many of the gains of the 60's have been eroded by a well-organized white community and misinformed elements of the black community. Therefore, Congressman Fauntroy believes, the plan is a necessity.

Some of the major points of the plan highlighted were a call for blacks to "buy and bank black," "support the black church" "register to vote" and increase the financial support of black institutions by sending in a monthly contribution.
