Although the series is named for the large NCCU auditorium, the more intimate setting of the University Theatre in the Farrison-Newton Building will be the site for the third program in the series. "Touch, The Mime Trio" will perform at 8:15 p.m. Thursday, November 18, in the University Theatre.

Delphin and Romain, a classical piano duo, attracted a large audience for their Valentine's Day performance last year at NCCU. The two black pianists will present their concert this year at 3 p.m., Sunday, February 13, in B.N. Duke Auditorium.

## Watercolors and Ceramics To Be Displayed

Watercolors by Durham artist Nancy Tuttle and ceramic works by Chapel Hill sculptor Dino Read will be featured at the Horacc Williams House in Chapel Hill during November.

Tuttle's works show an interest in sculptural handmade paper. Recent paintings utilize liquid watercolor and pastel overlays, with color ranging from subtle to vivid. The artist uses geometric shapes to confine dynamic central areas.

Read explores large grouped forms, dealing with fantasy and myth — often

with humor. The pieces have rich surface textures. Decorative graphics and tints of gold accent the strongly modelled terra-cotta shapes.

The show will run from October 31 through November 29, at the Horace Williams House, 610 E. Rosemary St., Chapel Hill. The house is open on weekdays, from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

There will be an opening reception Sunday, October 31, from 2 to 5 p.m. Admission is free and the public is cordially invited.
