**New Approach Developed For Detecting Asbestos**

A new technique for measuring iron-coated asbestos fibers in the lungs could play a significant role in future diagnosis of asbestos-related diseases, say two medical scientists at Duke University Medical Center.

The two pathologists have developed a technique for counting the iron-coated asbestos fibers in samples of lung tissue. Their technique is an effective screening method that requires much less lung tissue and is simpler than the tissue method currently used.

"Techniques for measuring asbestos fibers are very important in medical-legal situations where a patient has asbestosis, scarring of the tissue throughout the lung, or mesothelioma (cancerous tumors on the lungs)," said Dr. Victor Roggli, an assistant professor. "Based on the number of fibers found, we could say whether the tumor is likely to be related to asbestos."

The new technique was developed by Roggli and Dr. Phillip Pratt, Duke professor and director of laboratories at the Veterans Administration Medical Center.

They also developed an equation for determining the approximate number of asbestos fibers in the entire lung. Based on their equation, if two asbestos fibers are

found in a 5 micron tissue section (approximately the size of a quarter and thinner than a sheet of paper), then there would be an estimated 200 fibers per gram of lung tissue.

This would be more than 10 times the number of asbestos fibers found in a gram of normal lung tissue, Roggli said.

Pratt was a member of the National Committee for Pathology Standards for Asbestosis sponsored by the National Institute of Occupational Safety and Health.

That committee recently decided that the presence of two asbestos fibers in a tissue section and scarring around small airways in the lung is minimal evidence for diagnosing asbestosis.
