

# BET To Produce Talent Show In Washington/Nashville

WASHINGTON — Black Entertainment Television (BET) has announced its plans to produce a talent show in Washington, D.C. and Nashville, Tennessee, for telecast by the Washington based cable television network. BET president Robert L. Johnson said that his network and Spitzer/Ladrum Productions will co-produce a series of 30-minute talent shows designed to give new and emerging black talent in all areas of the performing arts an opportunity to perform before

a national cable TV audience. The program, "Best BET's", will be taped in Nashville and Washington using local black talent from both cities.

In making this announcement, Johnson said, "Best BET's is being developed as a showcase for new and talented black performers in dance, music, drama and comedy who rarely have the opportunity to reach national au-

diences. BET anticipates that this program will give millions of cable viewers the opportunity to see top rate entertainment, while at the same time provide exposure for some very talented artists. Black Entertainment Television and Spitzer/Ladrum Productions are eager to work with the black performing arts communities in both Washington and Nashville to select talent for this series."

## A Pocket Guide To Cold Water Survival

A boat capsizing, a car going off a bridge — there are a lot of ways you could find yourself unexpectedly immersed in water. And now, with temperatures falling, surviving in the water means not only staying afloat, but also conserving body heat. The U.S. Coast Guard has compiled some tips that could save our life in a Pocket Guide To Cold Water Survival. If you're involved in a cold-water accident, try to make your entry into the water gradual rather than abrupt. For example, stay with a sinking boat as long as there's anything left to hang onto, and keep as much of your body out of the water as possible. A sudden plunge into icy water can send your breathing rate up uncontrollably, causing you to take water into your lungs. If there's no way to avoid a jump or fall, keep your elbows at your sides, cover our nose and mouth with one hand, and hold that wrist or elbow with the other hand.

Once you're in the water, the danger of drowning is compounded by the threat of hypothermia — a condition where your body loses heat at its core, with effects ranging from numbness and disorientation to unconsciousness and

death. To maintain body heat, you need to trap the small amount of water that's inside your clothing and let it warm up. So button up immediately. And don't swim any farther than the closest object you can hang onto (swimming pumps the warmer water out of your clothes and lets colder water in).

If you're wearing a life vest, your chances of surviving are improved considerably. In addition to protecting you from drowning, a life vest allows you to maintain the best position; arms folded across your chest with hands tucked in. If you have to tread water or hang onto something to stay afloat, don't extend your arms or legs any more than is necessary. And keep as still as possible. This may be painful, but the pain won't kill you — and heat loss can.

Finally, while you're waiting to be rescued, try to keep your optimism up and think positively. In many cases, a stubborn "will to live" has been what's pulled people through.
