## Community

### Goal I

To improve the community's existing man-made environment

### Goal II

To ensure that new development enhances the community, while accommodating the expanding population

### Goal III

To maintain and increase opportunities for recreational activities

### Goal IV

To preserve and enhance the availability, accessibility, and diversity of cultural resources in North Carolina communities.

### Goal V

To reduce the incidence of crime and its effects on individuals by improved crime prevention and law enforcement efforts.

### Goal VI

To establish a more effective and equitable system of dealing with criminal offenders

### Goal VII

To ensure a public policy development and decision-making process that is responsive to citizen concerns and equitable in the allocation of public resources

### Goal VIII

To organize and administer public services in an efficient, effective and productive manner and to pursue, where feasible, fundamental program changes which achieve major and continuing public service cost reductions

### Goal IX

To develop and maintain adequate and equitable means for supporting necessary public functions

## Economy

### Goal I

To maintain a favorable business climate in North Carolina

### Goal II

To improve access to capital for small business, industry and agriculture

### Goal III

To encourage and support the development of new technology and its utilization to increase productivity and to stimulate economic growth

### Goal IV

To improve the capacity of our training institutions to retrain and upgrade the existing work force

### Goal V

To minimize the economic dislocations resulting from changing technology and from shifts in demand in national and international markets

### Goal VI

To increase the opportunities for women to maintain continuity in the labor force

### Goal VII

To encourage more women to go into non-traditional occupations

### Goal VIII

To develop more effective community support systems to assist young people in making the transition from school to work

### Goal IX

To ensure the availability of adequate transportation facilities to support economic growth

### Goal X

To ensure the availability of adequate energy, especially electric generating capacity

### Goal XI

To provide adequate supplies of clean water to support anticipated residential, commercial and industrial growth

### Goal XII

To provide adequate wastewater treatment capacity to support anticipated residential, commercial and industrial development

## Natural Resources

### Goal I

To clean up North Carolina's air and water pollution hazards and prevent new ones from occurring

To insure an adequate supply, and equitable allocation, of North Carolina's water resources

### Goal III

To stop erosion and fertility loss of productive soils, and water pollution from agriculture and forestry

### Goal IV

To increase the productivity of our economically valuable resources up to their sustainable potential

### Goal V

To foster energy conservation, and encourage the transition to renewable sources of energy

**Goal VI**  
To preserve the values of sensitive environmental systems, fish, and wildlife habitat, prime farm and forest lands, and unique and aesthetic characteristics of natural areas.

To increase public access to outdoor recreation opportunities, and to preserve an adequate supply of these opportunities for a growing population

**Goal VIII**  
To improve our understanding of our natural resources, and to foster that understanding among the people of North Carolina

**Goal IX**  
To protect legitimate public interests in decisions affecting the use or conversion of natural resources

**Goal X**  
To make state management of natural resources simpler and more effective, and to provide adequate financial support for it.
