When buying your railroad ticket, be sure to get a receipt for same from the ticket agent, so that the Secretary may know how much to refund you, as positively no fares will be refunded unless this receipt is shown.

At each of the above stores from which you buy goods, ask for a Rebate Coupon, showing the amount of goods purchased and date. After concluding your purchases, present ALL of your coupons, together with your receipt for railroad fares, to the secretary and your railroad fare will be refunded as follows:

Upon the purchase of goods amounting to \$1.50, from any one or more of the above named stores, your railroad fare, both coming and going, will be refunded, provided you do not come a greater distance than fifteen miles. Upon the purchase of goods amounting to \$2.00 your fare both coming and going, will be refunded, provided you do not come a greater distance than twenty miles; or upon the purchase of goods amounting to \$2.50 your fare will be refunded, provided you do not come a greater distance than twenty-five miles. This plan may be extended for any distance upon the same scale.

No fares refunded on purchases less than \$1.00.
All coupons presented to the secretary for any one fare must bear the same date.
After concluding your purchases, if you haven't time to call upon the secretary, rebate coupons may be mailed to him and your fare be refunded by mail.
