A PROCLAMATION. By His Excellency DAVID S. REID, GOVERNOR of the State of North Carolina. WHEREAS, three fifths of the whole number of members of each House of the General Assembly did at the last session pass the following Act:

AN ACT to amend the Constitution of North Carolina. SEC. 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of North Carolina, that the second clause of the first Article of the amended Constitution ratified by the people of North Carolina on the second Monday of November, A. D. 1835, be amended by striking out the words "and possessed of a freehold worth at least one hundred acres of land," and inserting in their stead the words "and of the age of twenty-one years (except as hereinafter declared) who have been in this State for one year immediately preceding the day of its enactment and shall have paid public taxes, shall be entitled to vote for a member of the Senate."
