As Amended and Changed by the State

Executive Committee.

We publish herewith a carefully corrected copy of the Democratic Pian of Organization in Morth Carolina, as amouded and changed at the recent meeting of the State Executive Committee. All Democratic conventious hereafter will be held, aud all Democratic candidates will be nominated according to this amended plan, and therefore every Democrat should read it and learn its provisions. It is as follows:

PRECINCT ORGANIZATION. 1. The unit or county organization shall be the voting precinct. In each precinct there shall be an executive committee, to consist of five active Democrats, who shall be elected by the Democratic voters of the several precincts in the meeting tirst called by the County Executive committee. And said committee so, elected shall elect one of its members as chair-

man, who shall preside at all committes meetings!.....
