

North Carolina and the Negro.

Dr. Washington has just completed his tour of the seventh State he has visited on his investigation of the condition, and progress of the negro people of the South. This is North Carolina, and he finds that there his race has attained in some respects, the highest degree of contentment, prosperity, and amicable relations with the whites of any in the Southern States. His report of conditions there indicates that the negroes are making substantial progress in industry, education, and the professions and that they are receiving to that end great help from influential whites.

During the meetings on his tour Dr. Washington was often introduced by the mayor of the city, and this official not infrequently referred in praise to the industry, sobriety, and law-abiding character of the black race. In several instances prominent white men and women aided in the entertainment of the visitor, and at no place was hostility to his presence shown. In a number of towns the proprietors of large industries have exhibited a commendable spirit in aiding in the education of the negroes. They have assisted at the establishment of schools and have given hospitals and church buildings to the blacks. It is good to see North Carolina taking the lead in this movement.—Fram the Chicago Tribune.
