

DEATH OF MR. JULIUS B. JUDD.

**Prominent Young Business Man
Five Years in Dallas Texas,
Is No More.**

Mr. Julius Bell Judd died of heart trouble March 11, at his home 327 Mason street, Dallas Texas. This sad announcement carried grief to many a heart for he had many warm friends who loved him dearly. In connection with his brother, Mr. Claud D. Judd, he had been traveling for the Grand Rapids Show Case Company, of Grand Rapids, Michigan, most of the time since they were boys, and were among the best known and most successful salesmen they had. Mr. Julius Judd had been on the road for a four weeks' trip and came home Friday morning, March 10. His heart (which had given him much trouble even before his father's death) troubled him more than usual on his last trip. He continued to complain of his heart, so Saturday morning a physician was called and he told Miss Mary Judd her brother Julius would be all right Sunday, but he grew worse and died Saturday, March 11, about 2 o'clock, p. m. Mr. Judd formerly lived in Henderson, N. C. He was the youngest son of Dr. and Mrs. W. J. Judd, of Henderson. Dr. Judd was for years a prominent and most beloved physician of Henderson and Mrs. Judd (who was Miss Augusta Solomon of Franklin County) was a most excellent and highly educated lady. Mr. Judd was a member of the First Baptist church of Henderson. He was so honorable, gifted and talented, it seems hard to see such a splendid business man cut down before he reaches the prime of life. The funeral services were held Sunday at 4 p. m., at the home and were conducted by Rev. James Thornton Lodge. The active pall-bearers were: Jacob Metzler, Lawrence Pollock, J.
