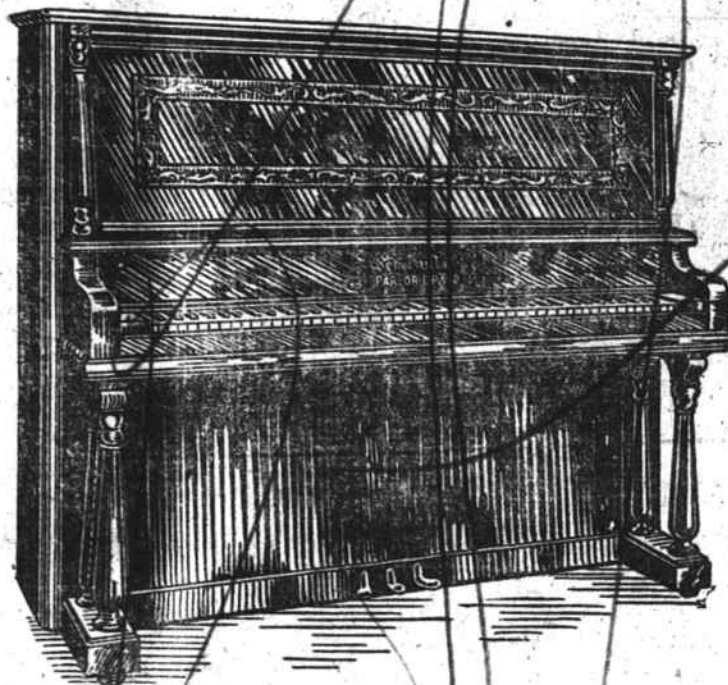
Parties living in one district are not confined to voting for candidates in their particular district, but may vote for any candidate in any district in the territory of the contest.

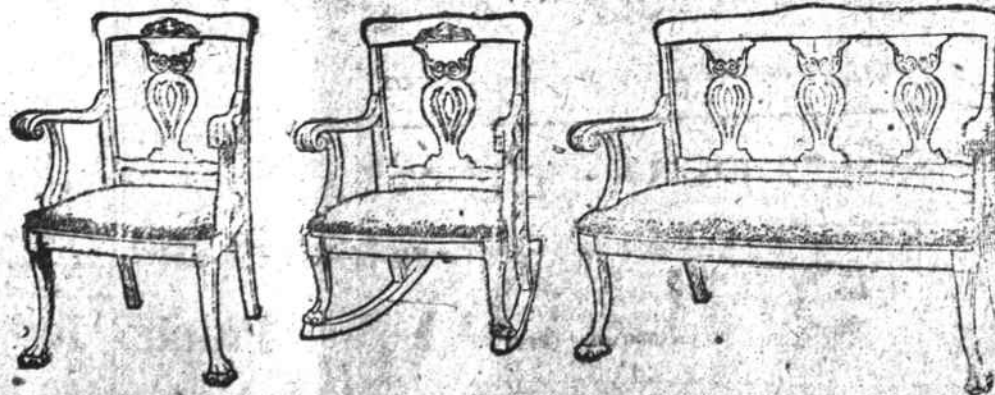
