French and British troops. AMERICANS LICK 'EM AGAIN. The Americans on the sectors where they are alone or brigaded with allied troops everywhere are fighting with a spirit of abandon that places them rightly in the category of veterans. Near the Neufly wood, which lies northwest of Chateau Thierry and at a point where the drive has brought the enemy nearest Paris the Americans have beaten off a strong attack, and on the Marne at Chateau Thierry, fighting shoulder to shoulder with the French, they have forced the first contingent of the enemy to cross the Marne and seek refuge on the northern bank of the stream. In this last engagement the Germans suffered severe casualties and also left ten machine guns in the hands of the defenders.

CHURCHMAN SUCCESSFUL. The German have captured Perment and the village of that village. The French have captured a large number of prisoners and they also took the town of Perment (Vaudry) in the northwest of Chateau Thierry during which the German hands several prisoners. In the work room 4,204 pairs of surgical dressings, 2,330 pairs of surgical dressings, 2,000 pairs of absorbent pads and 200 frigidation pads were completed. To the Grocers Merchants of Franklin County. The canning and preserving season will soon be here and under a recent ruling of the Administration sugar may be sold in quantities up to fifty pounds for canning purposes. It is necessary for those buying sugar for use in canning to sign certificates stating that the sugar will be for canning and preserving only and that it will not be over a thirty days supply.

For the convenience of the merchants I have on hand a supply of these certificates which they may obtain by writing to me for them, or they may get them direct from the Food Administration office at Raleigh.
