As a result of Quarantine and strict Sanitary Laws throughout the world, man's life has been extended. People are living longer. There were only 17 deaths in the United States last year out of every 2000 as against 23 in 1911. By better protection of health the death rate should continue to be reduced. Now let us do our part toward lengthening our lives with more ease and comfort. We are going to clean up and make sanitary the conditions of Louisburg. The Town has the name or reputation of being the dirtiest and most unsanitary Town in the State. The Inspector will come to see the householders of Louisburg on the 15th of present month to see what you have done toward helping your Health Officer do this most important work.
