BRIDGE TO LET

The Board of County Commissioners will let to the lowest bidder a bridge across Sandy Creek in Sandy Creek township, and known as the Person bridge on Monday, August 7th, 1922. The construction to be according to the specifications as follows: Bridge to be 140 feet long built of one 20 feet 1-36 steel strand, 2-15 wood spans in concrete-pillows, 2 middle pillars to be 3 feet at bottom and 2 feet at top 15 feet long, 2 buttment pillars 3 ft at bottom 18 inches at top with 8 ft wings. Scoring to be 4 in. County to furnish steel and cement. F. O. B. Louisburg, bidder to furnish all other materials. All pillars to be on solid foundations and height sufficient to bring bridge level with road bed.
