TO CLOSE COTTON POOL ABOUT MARCH 1ST

Raleigh, Jan. 22.—Cotton continues to be delivered to the North Carolina Cotton co-operatives at the rate of about twelve hundred bales weekly...

It is expected that all pools will be closed around March 1st, and it is expected that members will complete their deliveries before that time.

More than 130,000 bales of cotton have been ginned by expert graders, and it is believed that the association will get at least ten thousand bales more before the season closes.

Checks totaling \$2,756,000 have been sent to members for the second advance of \$25 per bale on all cotton delivered prior to December 1st...

Preparatory to beginning an active campaign of organization of community locals in every cotton growing county in the State, county meetings are being held at county seats.
