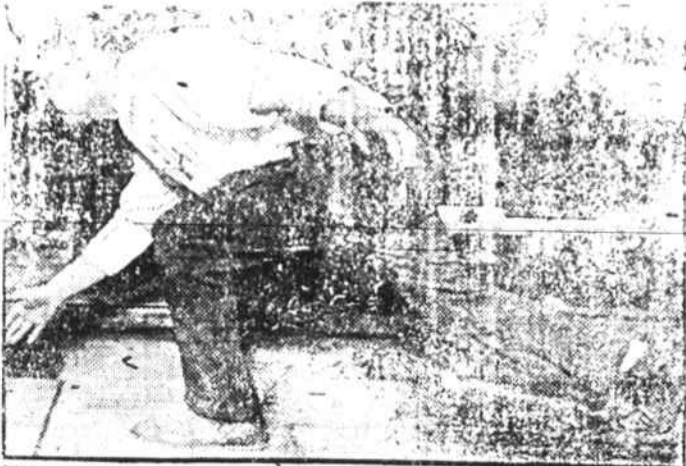


HERE'S WORLD CHAMPION BOWLER IN ACTION
