Your Conversation 'PAVILION'

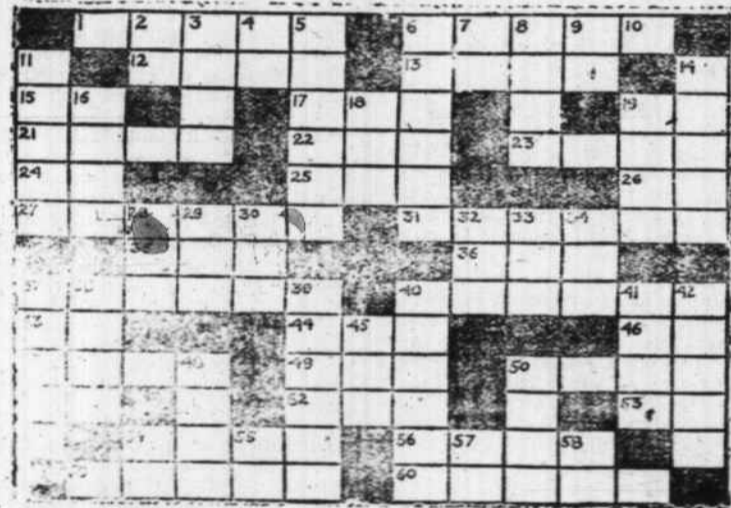
