It is because they are failing to put into training the one big faculty of their lives that counts so much. God has done all He can until He can get you lined up in attitude with Him. Are you weak? If so, is not the trouble with you? Isn't it because you have not been giving God a chance in their life? I am impressed with the fact more and more that we are going to have to call a halt in our daily life. We cannot leave God out on our program. If we do we are fools. There are thousands leaving God completely out of their lives. What would you think of a person who said he never expected to sleep any more in this world. You would think him crazy. A man would be perfectly foolish if he would come to you and say he was going to cut out communion with God. God has given us that faculty; he wants us to exercise it, use it, train it. He wants us to become like Him. How shall we do it, if we do not pray, if we do not commune with Him. It matters not at all what position you are in. The old custom is to be on your knees, but I think I have had some of the finest communion with God while standing, or sitting, or riding, as on my knees. It is the attitude of the mind and heart that counts. What are you going to say? I would not be surprised if it would not help us tonight if we would take less time asking God for so many things and spend some time thanking God. Stop and say Lord I am thankful for this thing and that thing. I am glad Brother Dowd brought into our revival the spirit of thanksgiving and of praising God. Read the Psalms and you will find there one of the finest expressions of prayer you will want to know anywhere. See how many times the psalmist took up space to thank God for things. Praise the Lord for this; thanksgiving for that. Pass it on and on, thank the Lord. It might do us good to stop tonight and take a long time to thank the Lord for what He has been doing for us in this way and that. Let Him understand that we do not undertake to inform Him as to what we are doing in this world. God knows that already. What He wants to know is will you give Him a chance to put His will through you to be lived out and the big trouble with us today is we will not give Him a chance. Go to a man and ask him to help you out on certain causes in the church and he sees how little he can do instead of showing how much. Like a man not long ago. I had a thing I wanted to put over in my church. I had one man whom I thought I could depend upon for strong support. I had expected several hundred dollars from him. He gave \$10. What will a man do to help carry out the work of the kingdom when we look at the Lord in a ten per cent way like that. If we expect to make the kingdom of God broad and big we must let it get hold of our lives. It is not so big, and all because there is lack of prayer in life. You may not have prayed to this time, but there is coming a time when you will offer a prayer to God. There will be a time when you will call to God. There are a lot of folks that prayed back yonder when the war came on as they had never prayed before. There are people in this world who get upset and anything to upset or frighten will send them to God whether there be any sincerity or not. Much of the praying of christian folks I am afraid is in line with that that took place in the lives of two Irishmen who were coming to America. They were on the way over here and while coming across the seas a big storm came up. They had heard that you could talk to God some way, somewhere, and he would hear. They thought it was time to pray. Pat said to Mike: "You lead us in prayer." Mike said "No Pat you lead us in prayer." Back and forth about three times it went. Finally one of them said, "Well, I will try it," and started out: Lord, this is the first time in all our lives we have ever called on you. We have never before asked you to help us. We are in an awful fix. We are about to be destroyed. We have not been coming to you with our burdens, but we come in this terrible time, and Lord if you will help us out of this circumstance we will never bother you again so long as we live. A certain type of professed christians are about like that. They wait until some trying experience gets on them, they then cry to God.

A man came to me once and said: "It looks like I am going to lose my boy. He has typhoid fever and it seems as though he will die in spite of all the doctors can do. I want you to pray for him to get well. I have not been coming to church like I ought to. I have not been praying to God like I should and I have not led the christian life that I ought to, but if my boy will get well I will pledge that I will live a different life. I will come to church and live right and pray to God." I said to him: "I shall pray for him and may God bring him back and save him for you." The Lord did it. He saved that young man. Do you think that man became a devoted church member. Upon my word as a christian man and as a pastor of the church, that fellow has not come to church one single time since that boy came to life. He made all sorts of promises to me, and to the Lord when he was in trouble. He was penitent then in a great state of alarm. Lord teach us to pray as John taught his disciples. We need to get definitely in line with Jesus Christ and let him teach us to lead the christian life. It is the sweetest thing in the world to live side by side with Jesus. how to pray, how to lead the christian life. It is our privilege tonight to take these lives and lift them out of the ordinary, out of the commonplace, raise them to sublime heights in Christ Jesus our Lord. He is waiting to see what He can do with that harp of life you have. You have not been giving him the chance. He wants it. Many a father and mother is agonizing today for a boy or girl they would like to turn from the path of evil. They are calling upon teachers, upon preachers, upon sources everywhere for help. Yet they have not been helping back there in the home. There was a widowed mother with only one son for her support, her comfort. She had prevailed upon him to give his life to God; she had plead with him to turn aside from his evil living, to know God and to live for

Him, but the son was only annoyed by her pleadings. He finally told her that if ever again she mentioned this thing to him he would leave home he would go away and leave her, for he could no longer stand her pleadings. The thought of religion was becoming unbearable to him. But the mother, so anxious over her son's soul, once again asked him to give his heart and life to God. And to this the son replied: "Mother I said if ever again you mentioned that to me I would leave. I am as good as my word. I am going. Get my clothes together and pack them for I am going." She got his things. She put them in a nice little grip. He went out of the door, down the steps, across the lawn and out of the gate.
