entative ask in January, when he visits me ANSWER: He will ask for the acreage of peanuts grown alons and also for the acreage grown with other crops. Then he will ask for the acres and pounds of "peanuts picked or threshed."

The last question is the number of tons of peanut hay saved. The first-two questions will include 'total acres picked or threshed, used for hay, hogged off or graz-Make the information you give the Census man or woman just as accurate as possible. This information is confidential.

QUESTION: Under what condition can a farmer sell meat?

ANSWER: The Extension Service is advised that farmers may sell their own meat providing they (1) collect ration stamps as required by the OPA; (2) observe OPA ceiling prices; and (3) mark the appropriate grade on the beef, veal, lamb, or mutton they offer for sale.
