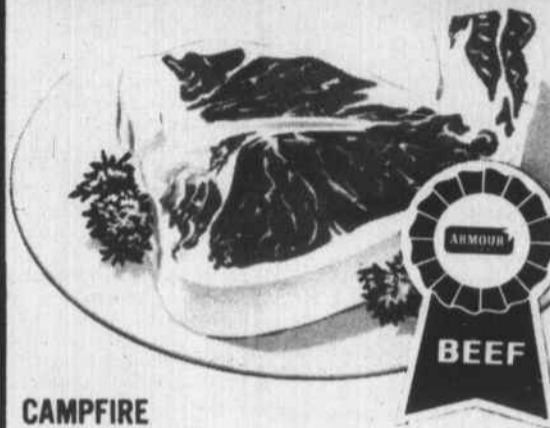
During the business session, envelopes were given out for State Missions, and the Circle discussed the society dues for each month.
