STATEMENT OF THE RESULT OF THE SPECIAL BOND ELECTION

held in the TOWN OF BUNN, NORTH CAROLINA on February 15, 1969

At a special bond election held in the Town of Bunn, North Carolina, on February 15, 1969, 137 voters were registered and qualified to vote.

At said election 84 votes were cast for the ordinance authorizing the Town of Bunn to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$160,000 Water Bonds of the Town for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for constructing a waterworks system for said Town, including the acquisition of any necessary land and rights of way, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 23 votes were cast against said ordinance, and said ordinance was thereby approved and is in force and effect.

This statement is given by order of the Board of Commissioners, this 17th day of February, 1969.
