Certification Date Set

Franklin county farmers will be expected to file a crop acreage certification at the ASCS Office in Louisburg again this year. May 31st. is the final certification date for wheat and barley on farms participating in the 1969 Wheat and Feed Grain Programs. June 30th. will be the final date to certify the acreages of tobacco, cotton, corn, and grain sorghum. Certifications should be made at the ASCS County Office just as soon as all of the above crops have been planted. Producers participating in the 1969 Wheat Program must sign a wheat acreage report by May 31, 1969 even if no wheat is planted for grain. Also, any producer participating in the 1969 Feed Grain Program who has planted barley must file a certification by May 31st. Failure to timely certify will mean loss of payment. Farmers are also reminded that it is very important that they plant within allotments, bases, or permitted acreages, and maintain the required amount of diverted acreage for the farm. Payments will be drastically reduced if program requirements are not met.

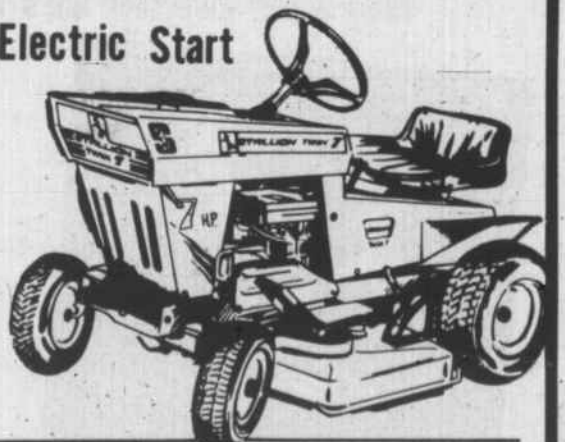

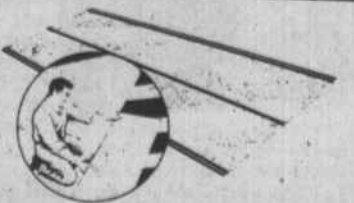
