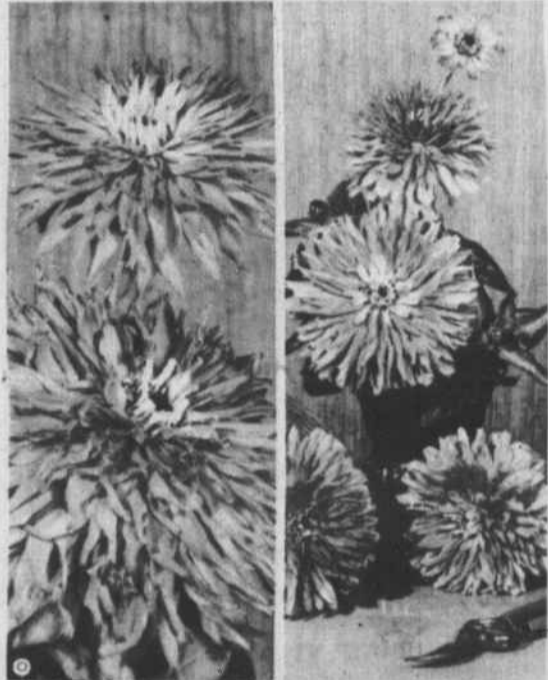
Revival

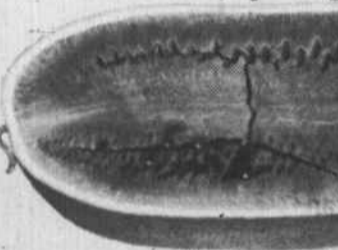

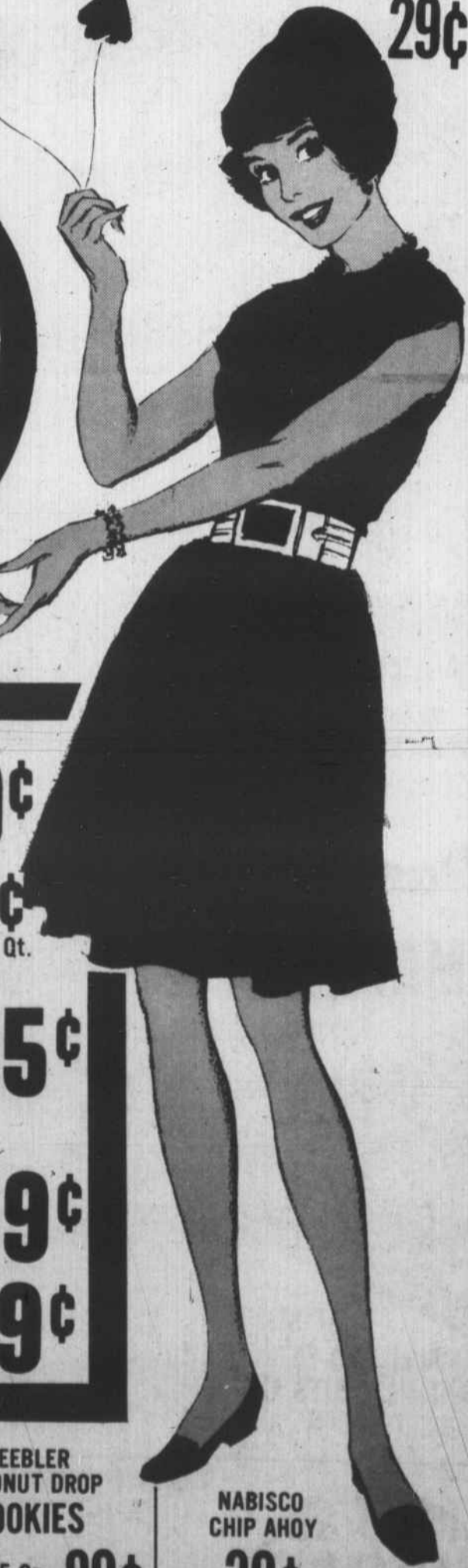
