

# Court Has Heavy Docket

## Superior Court

The following cases were disposed of last week during a term of Franklin County Criminal Superior Court:

Thomas Ferns East, Jr., driving under influence. Remanded to District Court for compliance.

Grady Ellis Thomas, driving under influence. 6 months in jail, suspended for 2 years on payment of costs; payment of \$100.00 fine; that he violate no law, State or Federal, during the term of the suspension of this sentence and surrender any driver's license he may have to the Clerk of the Superior Court.

Johnnie Alford Williams, driving under influence. 6 months in jail, suspended for 5 years on payment of \$200.00 fine and costs; that he violate no State or Federal laws; surrender his driver's license to C.S.C.

Bobby Wayne Fowler, ex-

ceeding safe speed. \$25.00 fine and costs.

Otis (nmn) Lynch, driving under influence. 6 months in jail, suspended for 2 years on payment of costs and \$100.00 fine; that he violate no State or Federal laws and surrender his drivers license to C.S.C.

Johnny Alvin Eastwood, felonious larceny. Not less than 5 nor more than 7 years in State Prison with work release recommended.

Willie Junior Perry, possession non tax paid liquor and possession for sale. 2 years in jail, suspended for 5 years; that he pay the costs of court and \$250.00 fine; that he violate no law of State or Federal government; that he pay into office of C.S.C. \$100.00 for attorney's fees.

Willie Edward Hicks, forgery. Not less than 3 nor more than 5 years in prison, suspended on payment of costs and a fine of \$100.00; that he violate no State or Federal laws; that he make full restitution to the prosecuting witness for forged checks.

Melvin Green, felonious assault. Not less than 3 nor more than 5 years in prison.

William Gene Williams, felonious larceny. Not less than 3 nor more than 5 years in prison, with work release recommended.

Charles Linwood Privette, felonious assault. Not less than 7 nor more than 10 years in prison, suspended and placed on probation for 5 years; to pay costs of court and the sum of \$2,000.00 to be disbursed to Franklin Co. Hospital for doctors, medical and hospital services rendered by Franklin Memorial Hospital to the prosecuting witness, and that the balance be applied on hospital, doctor's and nurses and medical bills at Duke Hospital.

James Robert Joyner, larceny. 5 years in prison, suspended on payment of costs; a fine of \$250.00; that he violate no State or Federal law.

Robert Edd Parrish, felonious assault. Not less than 7 nor more than 10 years in prison, suspended for 5 years; to pay costs and a sum not to exceed \$1500.00 for benefit of Franklin Memorial Hospital and Duke Hospital.

Joe Neal, carnal knowledge. Not less than 5 nor more than 7 years in prison.

suspended for 5 years on payment of costs and the sum of \$100.00 to Department of Social Services and thereafter pay \$25.00 per month into said Department. That he violate no law, State or Federal during this suspension; that he further pay into court the sum of \$200.00 for attorney's fees.

Julius C. Henderson, violation of probation. Probation revoked, and defendant ordered to serve sentence

Walter Edward Champion, w/m/38, non support. 12 months in jail, suspended on payment of \$30.00 per week for support and costs of court.

Lemuel Smith, non support. 12 months in jail, sus-

pending on payment of costs and \$25.00 per week for support.

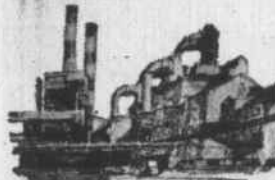
