"The after effects of grip," says a a recent balletin from the State Board of Health, is usually the worst part of the disease and it is just this for which fresh air is both a pre ventative and a cure. Grip sufferers usually feel that cool moving air would be the death o them but the trouble is they are not on good terms with fresh air and cant appreciate it's good qualities. They need to cultivate it's acquaintance by living in it every day, walking in it and sleeping in it at night.

"The saddest story connected with grip," says the bulletin, "is not that a person has the grip now but a later story that not infrequently follows, he never got over the effects of grip, or, his grip went into pneumonia or tuberculosis. Only fresh air, sunshine, rest and good food taken in time will prevent this sad story,"






