**STATE RESULT**

Returns from Many Counties Show Indications are Favorable for Bryan.

Laurensburg, Nov. 3—News from country precincts show large Democratic gains.

Elizabethtown, Nov. 3—County close. But almost certain we have elected part of ticket. Bryan will carry the county and Russell's majority if not will be very small.

Asheville, Nov. 3—Indications point to the defeat of the whole county ticket. Unable to say whether majority will be large or not.

Concord, Nov. 3—Bryan and Sewall carry the county by 1,000 majority. Shurtod, Populist, for Congress carries the county by 200 over Pemberton. Cy. Watson has 200 majority in this county.

Newton, Nov. 3—There was no scratching of electors here to-day. Two or three Democrats voted for Palmer. The Democrats have made gains at this precinct.

Shelby: J. F. Gardner—Populists support Bryan and Guthrie. No stickers used as known.

Fayetteville, Nov. 3—Every indication is that Cross Creek township, which includes Fayetteville, will give from 75 to 100 Democratic majority.

Piusboro, Nov. 3—Partial returns in Chatham indicate that Bryan will have 1,000 majority. Watson 200 plurality, and Stroud 500. Fusion county ticket elected by reduced majority.

Wilmington, Nov. 3—First complete precinct returns just received from Magnolia, Duplin county, gives Bryan sixty majority. Democratic gain over 1894, 110. Indications favor election of Carr, Democrat, to House from Duplin county.

Mocksville, Nov. 3—Davie will give a Republican majority of 300. This is a falling off of 50 per cent. from last year's vote.

Tarboro, Nov. 3—Democrats claim the county now. But few Democrats voted against Bryan. A few Palmer tickets cast at Tarboro, none in the county.

Winston, Nov. 3—It is conceded that Forsyth is Republican by 400 to 600 majority.

Oxford, Nov. 3—Reports indicate Granville for Bryan. Congressional very close.

Greensboro, Nov. 3—Returns from over half of the precincts in the county show a small majority on the Legislative and most of the county ticket. Settle is running behind his ticket.

Weldon, Nov. 3—Halifax has gone Republican. No scratching of Bryan electors. No vote here for Palmer and Buckner.

Waynesville, Nov. 3—Out of five precincts heard from, the Democratic aim is 200 over the vote of two years ago.

Winton, Nov. 3—Full fusion vote on State ticket and solid fusion on National ticket. Not less than five hundred majority on State ticket.

Statesville, Nov. 3—In all precincts heard from in Iredell county the Republicans have suffered loss.

Princeton, Nov. 3—This precinct gives State and county 140; Watson (plurality) 178; Pou, 126; Bryan, 229.

Dillsboro, Nov. 3—Gains as far as heard from. No scratching of electors. No Democrats voting against Bryan, not one for Palmer and Buckner.

Newberne, Nov. 3—Pollockville gives Bryan 22 majority; Watson 3 majority, a Democratic gain of 42.

Kinston, Nov. 3—Lenoir county elects Democratic member of legislature by 200 majority. Indications that the entire Democratic county ticket is elected, that Woodard for Congress gets 150 plurality.

Marion, Nov. 3—McDowell county gives a Democratic majority to the State and National ticket of 150.

Charlotte, Nov. 3—Meckleburg county gives the Democratic county ticket about 500 majority and the National ticket about 800 majority.

Carthage, Nov. 5—Indications are that the Democratic county ticket, except treasurer, is elected. Democratic member of the House certain. Bryan will have the county by about 700.

Nasheville; S. F. Austin—Populist voting for Guthrie and Bryan. Several negroes with us.

Rich Square, Nov. 3—Republicans have carried the county by about 500. There was no scratching of electors. Populists generally voted for Woodard. No Democrats voted against Bryan.

Elizabeth City, Nov. 3—Some white Republicans in the rural districts voted for Puckner and Palmer, from 100 to 200.

Hertford, Nov. 3—Perquimans give a considerable increase in the Democratic vote, and decrease in the Populist vote.

Piusboro, Nov. 3—Republicans carry the county to Kitchin by 1,000 to 400 majority. The balance of Democratic ticket is safe by 500.

Salisbury, Nov. 3—Bryan carries Rowan by from 1,000 to 1,200 majority. Watson's plurality from 800 to 1,000.

Winston, Nov. 3—Republican majority in Stokes is about 500. Very little scratching was done. Large vote polled. Populists voted the Democratic ticket, mainly.

Bryson City, Nov. 3—It is believed that the Legislative is barely safe in Swain. The National ticket runs ahead. Democratic State ticket has carried the county and Adams is with the State ticket.

Monroe, Nov. 3—At 11 p. m. the indications are that Bryan has 800; Watson 400; county doubtful.

Warrenton, H. A. Foote—Vote nearly closed here. Every Populist voted for Bryan and a majority for Watson, as far as known. Russell got one Populist vote. Negroes solid.

Goldsboro, Nov. 3—Courier reports to the Headlight gives a small majority for Wayne county, perhaps fifty.

Wilkesboro, Nov. 3—Wilkesboro township goes Republican as usual by the negro vote.

**Florida and Mexican Tobacco.**

General Weyler's edict to let us have no more Havana tobacco has caused the use of Mexican wrappers at Tampa, Florida. This stock makes up and smokes well, scarcely discernible from Havans by experts, especially in light colors. Mexican dark wrappers are glossier, however. The cost is about as much Havana wrappers. Florida tobacco culture is being largely increased every year and it is already largely substituting Havana, and there is no telling how much passes for it. There is a gradual transition state from the imported to the domestic article the consumer will hardly become aware till accustomed to it.—Exchange.

The above figures contain reports from Spring Hill, Toisnot (1), Stantonburg, Saratoga, Gardeners, Old Fields, Cross Road Taylors, Wilson, 1, 2, and 3. The above returns show that the Republicans have carried the county by about five hundred majority. Eli Felton, the opstable, Democrat, is probably elected. This is because there was no opposition. The returns from other three precincts will not alter the final result.

The Congressional race is very close in this county, with chances in favor of Woodard. Partial returns from other counties in this congressional district indicate that Woodard is re-elected by a small majority. The electoral ticket is safe for Bryan, the State Democratic ticket is divided between Russell, Watson and Guthrie, with chances favoring Watson.
