The application for a writ of habeas corpus in the case of Sergeant Mason has been granted by the Supreme Court and will be argued on the 17th inst.

The Democratic caucus of the New York Legislature has struck off the names of the Tammany members from the roll and ordered that they be not called in caucus hereafter.

SECRETARY F. LEEGE seems to be the strongest candidate for the gubernatorial nomination by the Republicans of New York.

It is proposed to modify the postal money order system by issuing postal notes for sums less than five dollars payable to bearer without sending letters of advice to the paying office.

THERE has been talk in the papers about Governor Jarvis and the United States Senate. This was all a rumor and the Governor has done and said nothing so far as we have seen to justify the rumor.

The colored Convention which met at Goldsboro last week was organized after somewhat of a storm.

The chief grievance complained of is that they are not allowed to sit on juries. We think this is mainly imaginary.

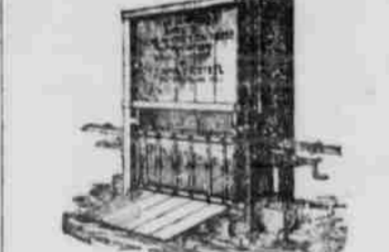
The Republican party is reviving its old tactics of brow beating and intimidation in this South.
