Queen Victoria's Income

A correspondent has been reckoning the income of the queen, and he came to. the conclusion that her majesty is the richest woman in the world, her fortune being worth about fifteen millions sterling. He reckons it thus: Annual income, nearly £400,000; expenditure, less than half than sum; annual saving, at least £200,000; add interest at three per cent per annum for forty-one years. This leaves out of reckoning the first two years, during which her father's debts, £200,000, were paid off. The in. 
