If the plans of the Niagara River Hydraulic Tunnel, Power and Sewer Company are carried out as arranged at the present time the mighty power of the Falls of Niagara will be utilized for the general benefit of mankind and for the financial enrichment of the stock holders in the enterprise.

Its purpose is to utilize the power of the Niagara River by constructing a subterranean tunnel from the water level below the falls, about 200 feet under the high bank of the river, extending through the rock to the Upper Niagara River a point about one mile above the falls, where a head of 120 feet is obtained.

The tunnel is then to extend, parallel with the shore of the river, one and one-half miles at an average depth of 100 feet below the surface of the earth and at a distance of about 400 feet from the navigable water of the river with which it is to be connected by means of conduits or lateral tunnels.
