RICHMOND, Va., January 20.—John S. Lacy, of New Kent county, was murdered last Friday night near Tunstall's station, on the Richmond and York River Railroad.

QUEENSTOWN, Jan. 20.—The British steamer Ocean, from New Orleans for Liverpool, went ashore in White Bay, inside the harbor, last night, while entering without her propeller, which she had lost. The crew were saved.

Woolen Mills Burned.

PHILADELPHIA, Jan. 20.—The fire at the woolen mills of John Brown & Sons, Eighth and Tasker streets, destroyed everything, leaving only the bare walls. Loss on the building and machinery is a quarter of a million dollars.

PITTSBURG, Jan. 20.—Nicholas Jacoby, who was shot on the street while carrying, paying his wife home early Thursday morning died yesterday. He made a dying declaration and stated that Frank Small, former lover of his wife, was his murderer.
