THE STATE CONVENTION.

The nominations made by the democratic State convention last week have given universal satisfaction. It is a remarkably popular ticket and is sure to win. Not only that, but the nominees are men unusually well qualified for the several offices for which they are candidates. Plainly they are so selected that every portion of the State is represented. The West is represented by the Attorney General and Superintendent of Public Instruction; the East by the Lieutenant Governor and Auditor; and the great centre by the Governor, Treasurer, and Secretary of State. The nomination of Mr. Bain was so peculiarly appropriate that the republicans will hardly nominate anyone other than in place of Mr. Duke who declined the nomination of their late convention. Indeed we hear that the leading republicans of Raleigh, incensed over Mr. Bain's nomination, wished him to do what would not have any opponents and telegrams were received from Mr. Duke, from Hon. D. A. Jenkins, the regular Treasurer from 1868 to 1876, posturing him their support.

While we regret that our distinguished countryman, Mr. A. H. Merritt, was not nominated for Superintendent of Public Instruction—a position for which he was eminently qualified—we congratulate him upon the distinctive vote given him for among the two candidates for the nomination of auditors, as it is evident that he received the second highest vote. The nominee, Mr. Finger, comes from Catawba the banner democratic county of the State, and will make a most faithful and efficient officer. The unanimous nomination of Judge Merritt is a decided compliment to so poor a man and so learned a jurist.

The delegates to the last convention are Hon. J. C. Riddle of Orange, Hon. W. T. Brown of Orange, Julius S. Carver of Durham, and George H. Brown of Beaufort. The two presidential electors for the State at large are Col. John N. Sprague of Guilford and Hon. W. H. Kidder of Halifax, who will make an active and vigorous canvass.

The convention was the most enthusiastic held that we have ever seen, but there was not the slightest bitterness of feeling exhibited nor an unkind or harsh expression uttered by any delegate. It was decidedly the best nated of not the best behaved body of men we have ever seen assembled together. Their powers of endurance seemed wonderful, and yet they did not hesitate to express their weariness of any speaker who trespassed too long on their patience. Many amusing incidents occurred, one or two of which we will recall. There was a little red-headed youth from Cheyenne sitting near the front, and during Maj. Latham's speech for Coker he was repeatedly pumping up his chair and would wave his hand high above his head and yell for Col. Coker at the top of his voice. His monkey mites caused much merriment, especially once when he mounted his chair, flourished his hat, yelled at the top of his shrill voice, and found himself alone in his glory! Another amusing incident occurred during Mr. Bowes' speech in seconding Coker's nomination. He was advocating most warmly Coker's claims and claimed, "And who then is the best man for Governor?" At once a thousand voices yelled out "Scales, Scales!" This unexpected answer check ed the speaker, but he quickly joined in the general laughter created at his expense.

A noteworthy fact connected with this convention was the number of delegates who had joined the "Liberals" two years ago, but had now returned to their "first love." Conspicuous among them was Mr. W. H. Day, of Halifax, who in 1862 can vassed the State in favor of the lib-erals, but now was a delegate from his county to this convention, and, in response to loud calls, appeared upon the stage and made a vigorous and eloquent speech. He said that the civil rights question ought to make all white men in North Carolina stand together in asserting the supremacy of the Anglo-Saxon race. The crowds were greeted with loud applause.

**The Democratic Platform.**  
At the State convention of the democratic party, held at Raleigh last week, the following platform or declaration of principles was unanimously adopted, and we commend it to the careful consideration of our readers:

We again congratulate the people of North Carolina on the career of peace, prosperity and good government on which she entered after the inauguration of the democratic State administration, and which has been unbroken for so many years since upon the just and impartial enforcement of the laws upholding the efficiency of our common school system and the great progress made in popular education and upon the general improvement and enterprise manifested in every part of the State; and we again challenge a comparison between this state of things and the crimes, outrages and scandals which attend the republican ascendancy in our borders, and we pledge ourselves to exert in the future, as we have done in the past, our best efforts to promote the material interests of all sections of the State. Affirming our adherence to Democratic principles as heretofore enunciated in the platform, it is hereby declared:
