A Horrible Railroad Accident. Chicago, Aug. 11.—The Chicago Times special from Forest, Ill., says: All the railway horrors in the history of this country were surpassed three miles east of Chatsworth last night, when an excursion train on the Toledo, Peoria and Western road dropped through a burning bridge, and over one hundred people were killed and five times that number were more or less badly injured.

Chatsworth, the next station east of Forest, is six miles off, and the run there was made in seven minutes, so the terrible momentum of those three hundred and two engines, shooting through space at the rate of a mile a minute, can be understood.
