A young negro, by the name of Schlegel, took hold of the young lady in a most unbecoming manner, and she, in a desperate effort to escape, screamed and fought for her life. He became infuriated at her struggles and ran, but she was not far from escaping when he was arrested by a patrol of men who were in the vicinity. They arrested him at his home, and he was soon taken to the jail.
