

LABOR IN POLITICS TO SPEND MILLIONS

To Be Used to Defeat Candidates Unfavorable to Labor; To Boost Favorable Ones

Alfred Hoffman, organizer for the United Textile Workers now at large under appeal bond after conviction of rioting at Marion, was at High Point the other day and while there he talked about the approaching campaign of organization of labor in this state as well as the political campaign.

Hoffman is quoted as saying that the American Federation of Labor had assigned a million and a half dollars to North Carolina and that a considerable portion of that will be used to defeat political candidates unfavorable to labor, as well as to bringing out labor candidates irrespective of party affiliation.

Both North Carolina senators are under the ban, it is said, and the first job of the labor folks will be to defeat Senator Simmons next year.

As Senator Overman does not come up for election next year no real fight will be made upon him at this time.

Frank Grist, commissioner of labor and printing, is also to go out, say the labor leaders. They do not like his attitude during the late troubles in textile centers.

Every candidate for the legislature next summer will be asked to express his views on the several measures which labor hopes to get enacted into law in this state, and there will be money available, it is hinted, to help those who answer favorably, while if the answers are not satisfactory labor candidates will be brought out against the field.

Which would seem to indicate that the American Federation of Labor is forsaking the wise policy of Samuel Gompers and other old leaders and is trying to build up a real labor political party like in England.

NEW NEWSPAPER FOR COUNTY OF STANLY

The Stanly News and Press is the name of a newly consolidated paper at Albemarle, the publishers of the Albemarle Press having recently bought the Stanly News-Herald and consolidated the two into a semi-weekly. The first issue came out Tuesday, December 3.

The paper is eight pages, eight columns and has an attractive make-up. J. D. Bivens is general manager, S. R. Andrews is editor and Tom W. Johnson is city editor.

Such a staff as that ought to assure a good newspaper for a country town like Albemarle.
