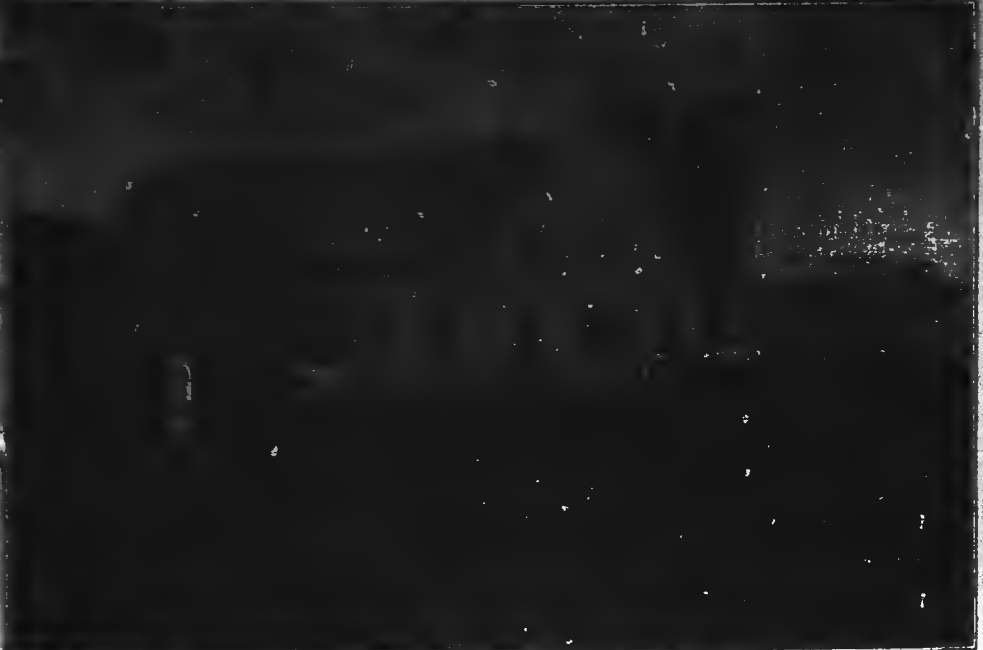


TYPICAL DAIRY BARN IN WILKES COUNTY

This is a petaled tavern for a soul!"

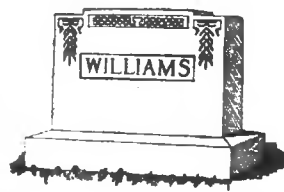
