Cyclone Kills At Least Five

Shreveport, La.—Five persons were known to have been killed in a cyclone that hit Tuesday damaged five residential sections of Shreveport, Louisiana's second largest city. Police said eight had been reported killed. Rescue workers believed the death toll might be higher after wreckage was cleared. "Many" were reported injured. Known dead were Mr. and Mrs. Bill Borgass, a man named Armstrong, a man named Woodyard, and an unidentified boy. The storm ripped down many communications lines. High winds and hailstones damaged houses and uprooted trees. The storm struck about 3:45 p. m. (c. s. t.) demolishing houses in the inside, Weyers Park, Queenston, Jewella and Brookmore sections. Three houses were damaged near Barkdale Field, one of the nation's largest army fields. An army sergeant was reported hurt in one house. Several persons were reported hurt by flying glass and falling roofs. Rescue workers were handicapped by sightseers who flocked to the scene, despite warnings that streets were littered with live electric wires.
