### Two Demonstrations Soon To Be Held

J. O. Rowell, extension entomologist, of State College, will be with us next week and assist in holding two Peach Tree Borer demonstrations.

The results of experiments conducted over the State within the past few years have proven that Ethylene Dichloride Emulsion has a number of advantages over Paradi-chlorobenzene for the Peach Tree Borer. Ethylene Dichloride Emulsion is effective at low soil temperature and can, therefore, be used late in the fall and early spring, when it is too cold for Paradi-chlorobenzene to be effective. It appears to be safer on young trees and does not require the attention of mounding as does the other materials.

Dichlor Mulsion may be applied in the south at any convenient time during the Fall Winter or Spring. Best results, however, will probably be obtained in the Fall at the end of the egg-laying period of the moths, when most of the borers are small.

The two demonstrations will be held on the farms of: W. W. Ferguson, 1 mile north of Mount Carmel church near Boomer, at 9:30 a. m. and the second demonstration on the farm of A. S. Clark, Millers Creek, at 11:00 a. m.

We are extending an invitation to all farmers who are interested in the control of Peach Borer to be present at one or both of these meetings.
