LIST YOUR PROPERTY! During January

Wilkes County Tax Listing will begin on Monday, January 13, in every Township, at places, dates, and with List Takers named below. All persons, firms and corporations of Wilkes County, and non-residents who own property in Wilkes County, are hereby notified that all real and personal property must be listed for taxation for the year 1947, as of January 1, 1947. (Note: Listing Starts in Rock Creek January 20).

All male persons 21 to 50 years of age are required to list for PollTax. All dogs, six months old or older, must be listed whether owned by the head of the household or any other member of the family. Be prepared to give necessary information for form census report. List your property while the records are in your Township—failure to list during the regular listing time makes you liable for penalty, and causes delay and expense in making up the tax books in the Supervisor's office.
