## AERIAL VIEW OF TRAILER CAMP AT STATE COLLEGE



Raleigh.—Pictured above is Trailwood, student trailer camp at N. C. State College, where approximately 550 persons are residing in 220 trailers. The students living in this area are all veterans of World War II and are studying under the provisions of the "GI Bill of Rights." In another emergency housing area on the State College campus, about 375 persons are living in 125 prefabricated housing units. In an attempt to provide class room space for the record-breaking enrollment of 4,902 students, State College recently completed the construction of 12 Quonset huts where classes will be held in some courses during the winter term. A request for appropriations to expand the physical plant of the institution will be presented to the General Assembly, which convened in Raleigh Wednesday.
