

From Bad To Worse

It was bad enough to have the division that came with the revolt of the ten tribes under Jereboam, but the conditions that prevailed following the revolt were still worse.

Upon his return to Jerusalem, Rehoboam assembled "all the house of Judah" for the purpose of going to war with his brethern of Israel in the hope of subduing the rebellious tribes and bringing them all together again under his own kingship. The word of God came to Rehoboam, however, through Shemiah, "the man of God," and the tragedy of the impending civil strife was narrowly averted.

Likewise, the conduct of Jereboam, following the rebellion, brought shame and reproach upon the people of Israel. In order to satisfy the desires of the people who were unable to go up to Jerusalem to worship, two calves of gold were made and set up, the one in Dan and the other in Bethel.

"And this thing became a sin: for the people went to worship before the one, even unto Dan." (1 Kings 12:30).
