dairy farmers held a meeting September 4 at the County courthouse in Wilkesboro to perfect the organization for the Artificial Breeding Program. C. C. Alexander, of Roaring River, was elected president; C. W. El-

ledge, of Hays, vice-president; and Fred W. Davis, secretary-treasurer. The following directors were elected: T. J. McNeill, Roaring River; W. K. Studvant, North Wilkesboro; and C. J. Hendren, Pores Knob.

Maury Gaston, Extension Representative for the Southeastern Artificial Breeding Association, was present to advise the new organization concerning the advantages of Artificial Breeding of dairy cows. The officers and directors met in the County agent's office September 8 to incorporate the new organization as a farmers cooperative. C. W. Sheffield, of the Division of Markets of the North Carolina Department of Agriculture, was present to advise on the legal aspects of the incorporation.

The farmers present authorized naming the organization Wilkes County Cooperative Artificial Breeding Association, Incorporated. They also authorized the farm agent to order the necessary equipment.
